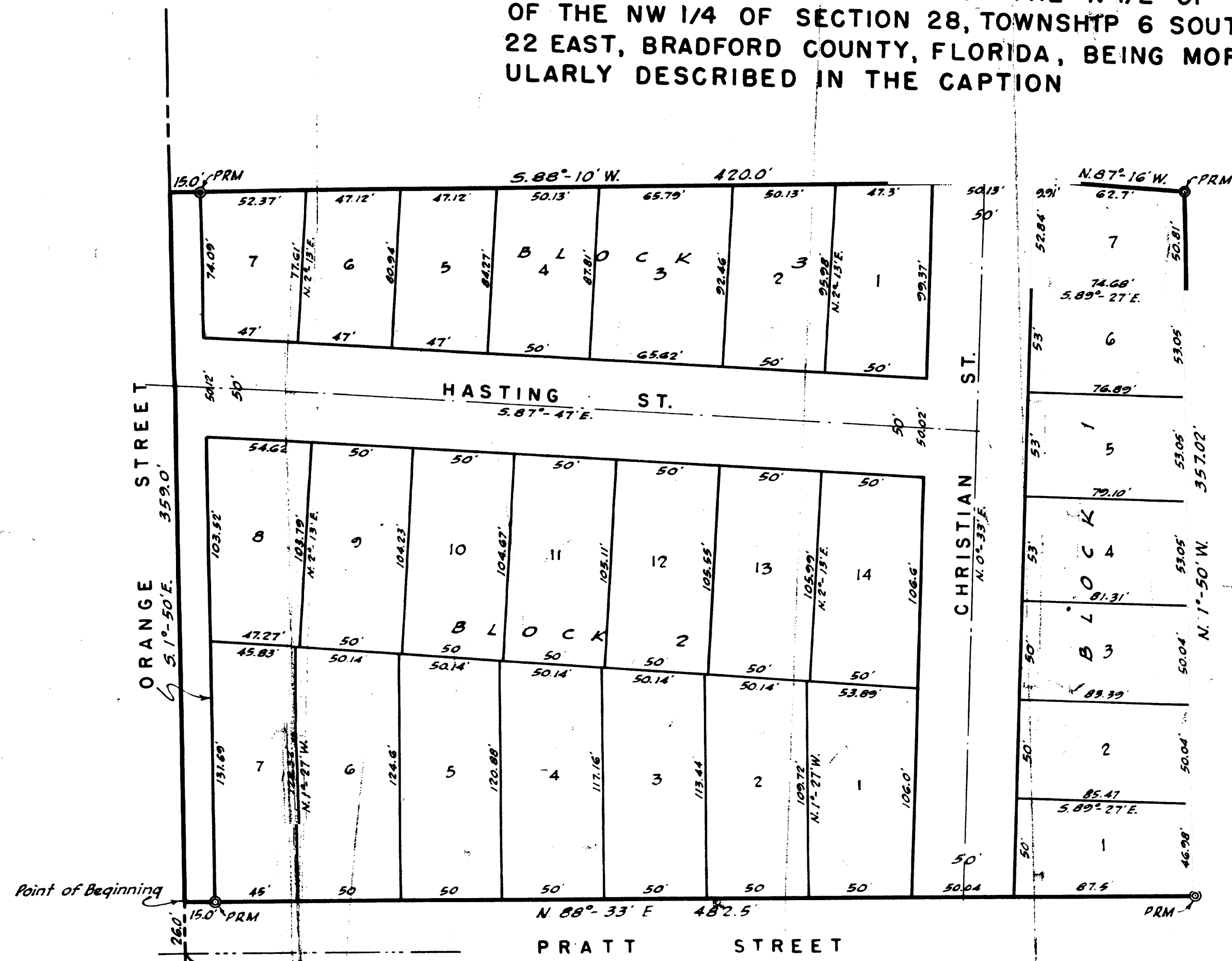


DOWLING PARK

CAPTION
For point of reference commence at the southwest corner of the North half of the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 28, Township 6 South, Range 22 East, Bradford County, Florida, and run North one degree, fifty minutes West (N. 1° 50' W.) a distance of twenty-six (26.0) feet to a point for point of beginning. From the point of beginning thus described run North eighty-eight degrees, thirty-three minutes East (N. 88° 33' E.) a distance of fifteen (15.0) feet to a permanent reference monument; continue thence North eighty-eight degrees, thirty-three minutes East (N. 88° 33' E.) along the Northernly boundary of the right-of-way of Pratt Street, a distance of four hundred eighty-two and five tenths (482.5) feet to a second permanent reference monument; run thence North one degree, fifty minutes

West (N. 1° 50' W.) along an old fence line a distance of three hundred fifty-seven and two hundredths (357.02) feet to a third permanent reference monument; run thence North eighty-seven degrees, sixteen minutes West (N. 87° 16' W.) along an old fence line, a distance of sixty-two and seven tenths (62.7) feet to a point; run thence South eighty-eight degrees, ten minutes West (S. 88° 10' W.) a distance of four hundred twenty (420.0) feet to a fourth permanent reference monument; continue thence South eighty-eight degrees, ten minutes West (S. 88° 10' W.) a distance of fifteen (15.0) feet to the line dividing Section 28 from Section 29, Township and range aforementioned; run thence South one degree, fifty minutes East (S. 1° 50' E.) along said dividing line a distance of three hundred fifty-nine (359.0) feet to the point of
