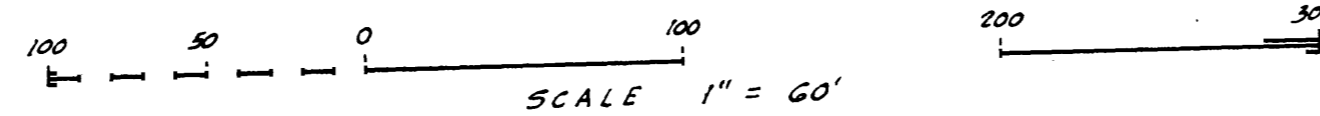
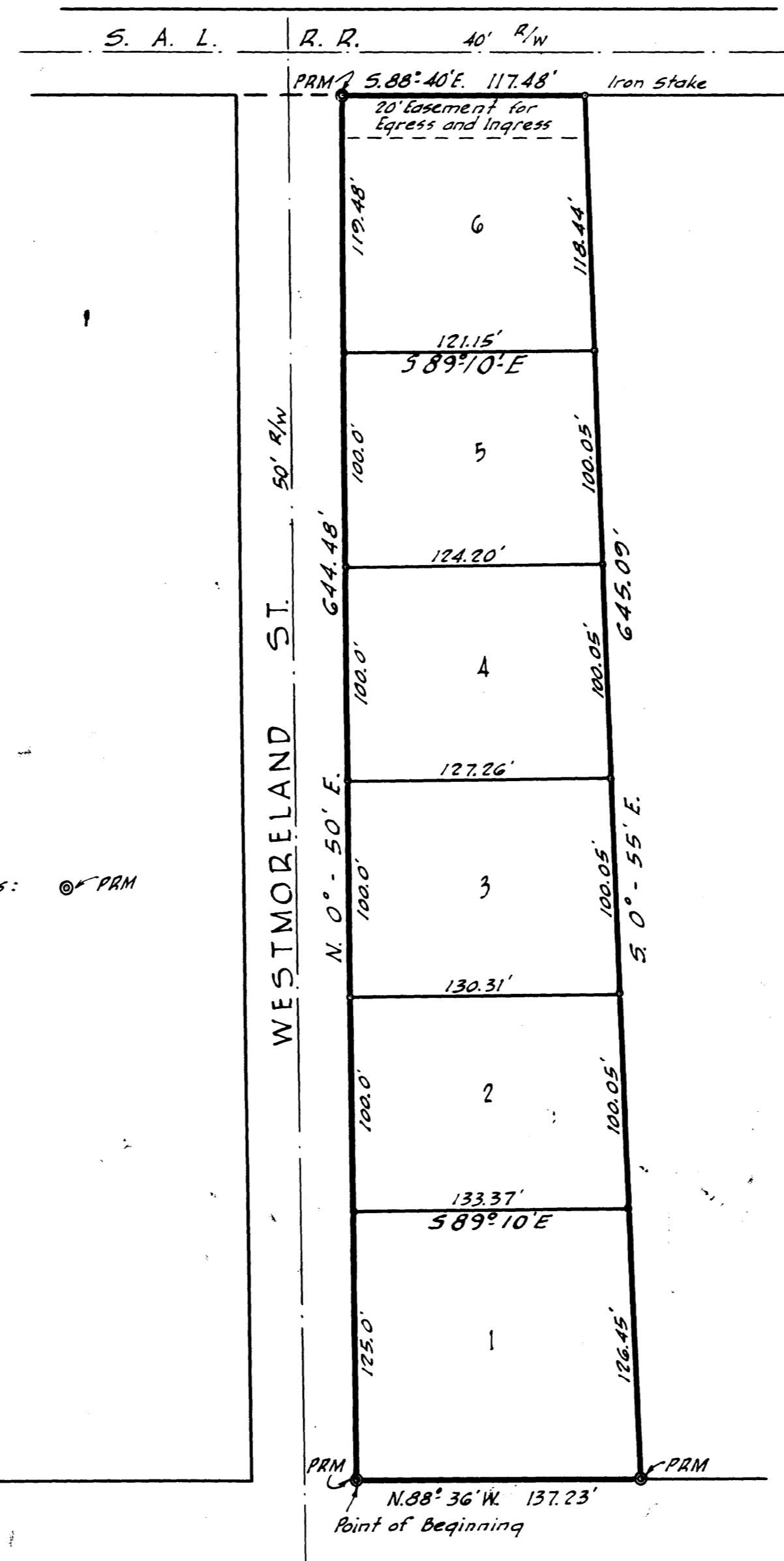
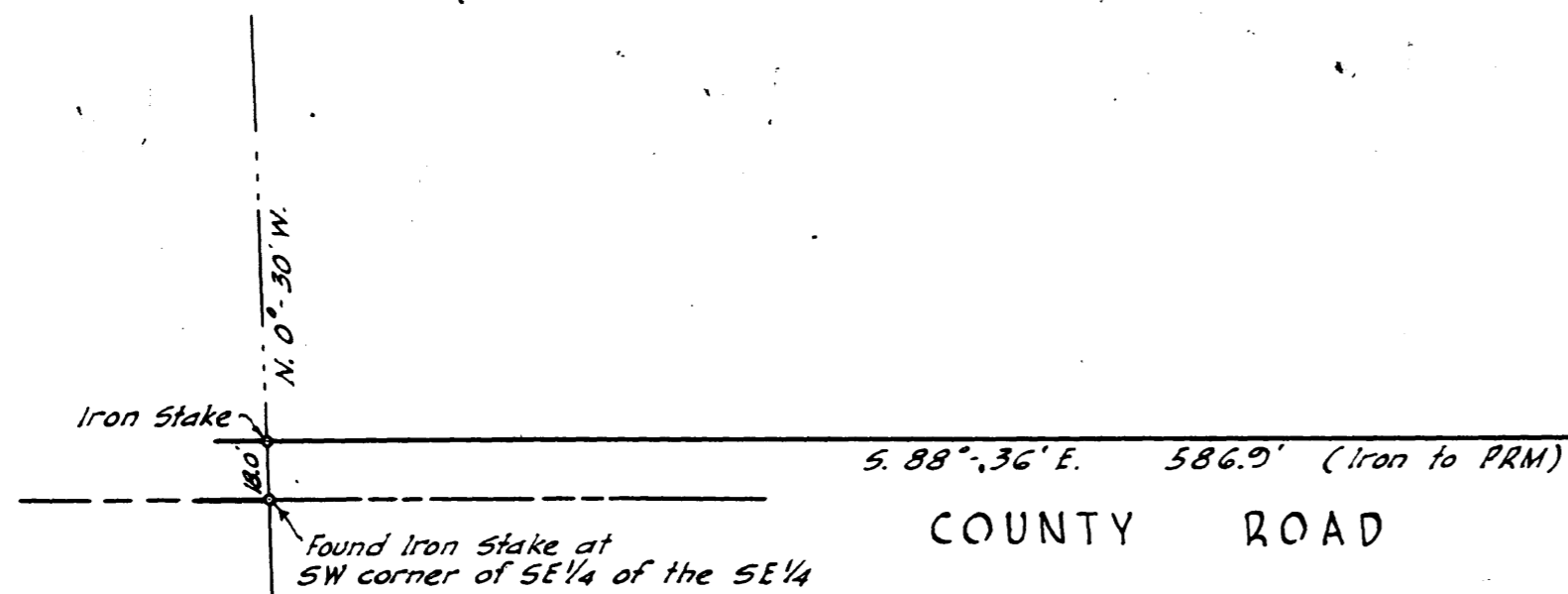


**GREAT OAKS**  
 ST ARKE, BRADFORD COUNTY, FLORIDA  
 A SUBDIVISION OF A PORTION OF THE SE 1/4 OF THE SE 1/4 OF

**CAPTION**  
 for point of reference commence at the Southwest corner of the Southeast Quarter (SE 1/4) of the Southeast Quarter (SE 1/4) of said Section 29 and run thence North zero degrees thirty minutes West (N. 0° 30' W.) along the West line of said Southeast Quarter (SE 1/4) of the Southeast Quarter (SE 1/4) eighteen (18.0) feet to an iron stake on the Northernly boundary line of the right of way of a County Road; run thence South eighty-eight degrees, thirty-six minutes East (S. 88° 36' E.) along said Northernly boundary line, five hundred eighty-six and nine tenths (586.9) feet to a permanent reference monument at the intersection of said Northernly boundary line and the Easterly boundary line of the right of way of Westmoreland Street for point of beginning. From the point of beginning thus described, run North zero degrees, fifty minutes East (N. 0° 50' E.) along said Easterly boundary line a distance of six hundred forty-four and forty-eight hundredths (644.48) feet to a permanent reference monument on the Southernly boundary line of the right of way of the Seaboard Air Line Railroad; run thence South eighty-eight degrees, forty minutes East (S. 88° 40' E.) along said Southernly boundary line a distance of one hundred seventeen and forty-eight hundredths (117.48) feet to an iron stake; run thence South zero degrees, fifty-five minutes East (S. 0° 55' E.) a distance of six hundred forty-five and nine hundredths (645.09) feet to a permanent reference monument on the Northernly boundary line of the aforementioned County Road; run thence North eighty-eight degrees, thirty-six minutes West (N. 88° 36' W.) along said Northernly boundary line a distance of one hundred thirty-seven and twenty-three hundredths (137.23) feet to the point of beginning.
