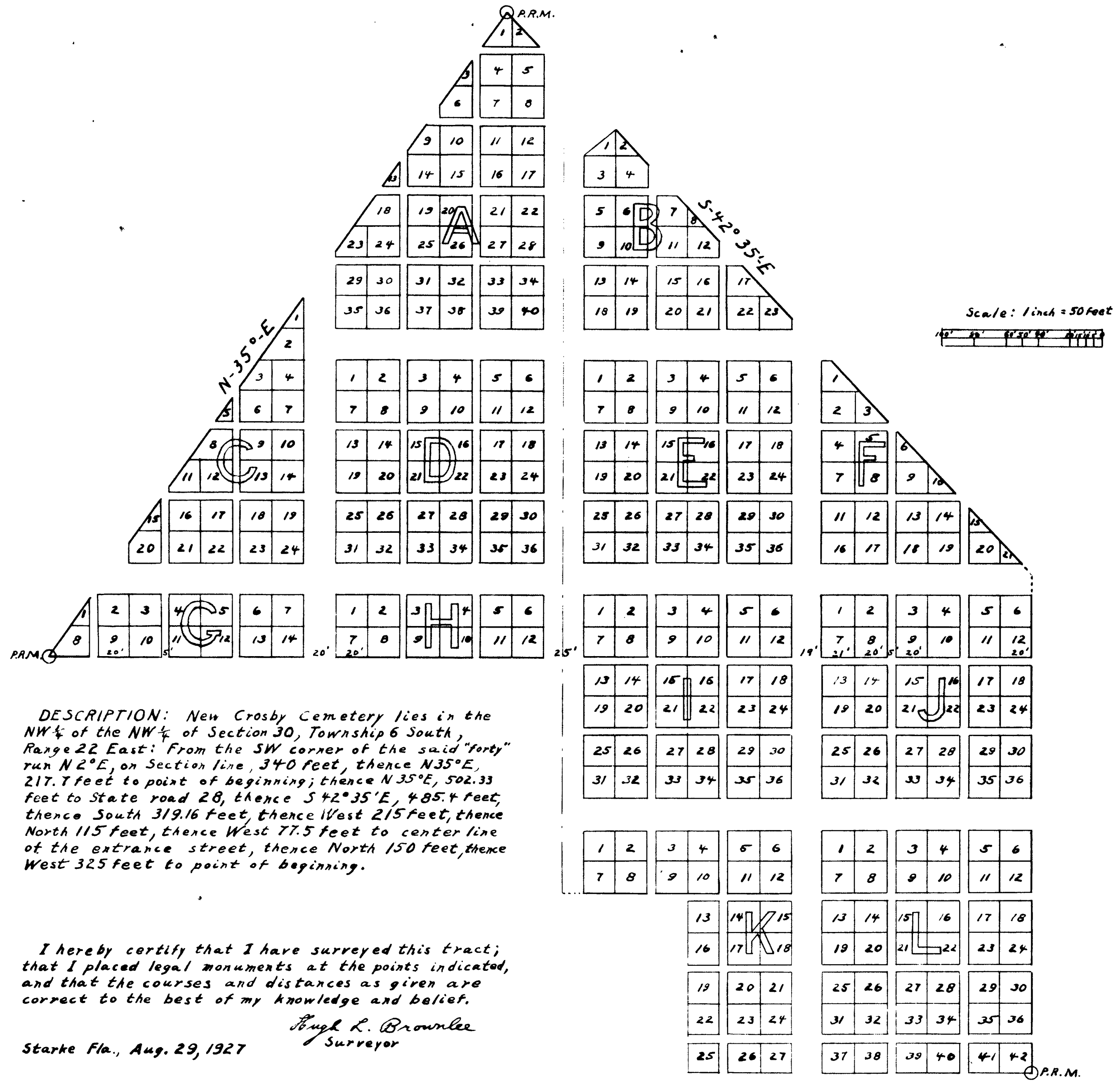

DESCRIPTION: New Crosby Cemetery lies in the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 30, Township 6 South, Range 22 East: From the SW corner of the said "forty" run N 2° E, on Section line, 340 feet, thence N 35° E, 217.7 feet to point of beginning; thence N 35° E, 502.33 feet to State road 28, thence S 42° 35' E, 485.4 feet, thence South 319.16 feet, thence West 215 feet, thence North 115 feet, thence West 77.5 feet to center line of the entrance street, thence North 150 feet, thence West 325 feet to point of beginning.

I hereby certify that I have surveyed this tract; that I placed legal monuments at the points indicated, and that the courses and distances as given are correct to the best of my knowledge and belief.
