



E S Matthews' Addition "A"
to Starke

Being a portion of the following described lands
Deeded by Jennie Hagaman to Eugene S.
Matthews, March 28, 1900 and recorded in
Book "V" of Deeds page 271 et seq. in the
Court House in Starke Florida, to wit:

Beginning at a post on the West
Side of Walnut Street, where the North line of the Southeast
quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section 28 Township 6 South
Range 22 East crosses the West side of said Street; thence
Southerly along the West side of said Street 170 1/2 feet; thence
Westerly at right angles to said Walnut Street 493 feet; thence
Northerly and parallel to said Walnut Street 6 1/2 feet to said north
line of said Southeast quarter of Northwest quarter, thence
east to place of beginning; containing one acre more or less.

Also.

all that certain parcel or lot of land situated in the Town
of Starke, Bradford County, Florida, described as follows:
Beginning at a post on the West side of Walnut Street 170 1/2
feet Southerly from where the North line of the SE 1/4 of the NW 1/4
of section 28 Township 6 South Range 22 East crosses the
West side of said Street; thence westerly and at right
angles to said Street 493 feet; thence southerly and
parallel to said Street 227 1/2 feet; thence easterly and
at right angles to Walnut Street 493 feet to West side

Walnut Street, thence Northerly along the West side
of Walnut Street to place of beginning 227 1/2 feet; con-
taining 1/4 acre more or less.

And all that certain parcel or lot of land by
being in the Town of Starke County, Florida, and State of
described as follows: All lots within certain lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17 in what is known and recorded in Book "V" of Deeds and 205 public records of said County, as Tract No. 1 and 2 of Starke; said blocks bounded on the north by Temple St. the West by Temple Street, South by lands of N.D. Hagaman on the east by Walnut Street. Also all those certain parcels or lots of land lying and being in the Town of Starke County of Bradford and State of Florida, described as follows: Commencing at northwest corner of N.J. Jones land thence north 55 feet to quarter section east, Section 28, Township 6 South, Range 22, East, thence east 492 feet on section line to lands deeded to N.D. Hagaman December 1886, being 493 feet West from Walnut Street; thence South and parallel to Walnut Street to Southwest corner of N.D. Hagaman land 234 feet; thence east 96 feet to northwest corner of N.E. Davis land; thence South and parallel to said Walnut Street about 332 feet to N.J. Jones land; thence West on said N.J. Jones line about 240 feet to post on line between said described lands and the Fuller lands; being 1/4 acre, more or less;

Said lands being bounded as follows: Bounded on the North by lands of S.J. Temple and African Methodist Church; on the South by town lots owned by N.J. Jones; on the East by town lots owned by N.D. Hagaman, N.E. Davis, F.P. Wall and E. Mason; and on the West by lands known as the Fuller land.
